Licenses: We'll Be Doing It Right

What We Had

Contradictory and bad information:

- The stated licensing terms are contradictory
 - Public domain
 - “Free” but invariant language
- Software, documentation, and data are conflated
 - Licenses for software and documents are not appropriate for each other
 - Software licenses need to be treated separately
- Licenses can mean different things different places
- **GO data was publicly described as not open.**

What We'll Have

Creative Commons BY (Attribution 3.0 Unported)

- Easy to explain and commonly used
 - Share, adapt, make commercial use
- Allows what people would reasonably want to do
- Gives credit for our work
- International

What We'll Have

Creative Commons BY (Attribution 4.0 Unported)

An improvement on 3.0

- More clear
- More international
- Deals with data
- Used by others (UniProt)

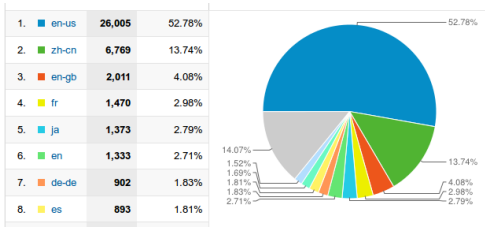
Inward
